Hazard is an object or situation that has the potential to harm a person, the environment or cause damage to property.

Common workplace hazards



Types of Hazards

- Physical hazards slips, trips and falls, equipment maintenance, constant loud noise, radiation, UV rays, temperatures(hot and cold)
- Biological hazards bacteria, viruses, mold, insects/pests, blood & other body fluids
- Chemical hazards air-borne vapor, cleaning products, asbestos, dust
- Ergonomic hazards improper lifting technique, repetitive movements, improperly adjusted workstation.
- Psychological hazards bullying, harassment, stress-related, long hours, workplace demands

Occurrence arising out of, or in the course of, work that could or does result in injury and ill health.

Immediate causes

- Unsafe Acts are failures in the way that people perceive their surroundings and how they interact with them. Unsafe acts are human errors that contribute to accidents such as:
 - walking under an overhead load
 - using defective equipment
 - not using proper Personal Protective Equipment
- Unsafe Conditions are failures, whether conscious or unconscious, in the safety system and are shown by compliance with approved standards dealing with physical conditions.
 - · hazardous environment

- Inadequate guard or barrier
- Inadequate warning system
