

Hairdressers/Salons Operational Standards

Cleaning & Disinfection

All workstations, tools, and multi-use items must be cleaned and disinfected according to risk level—low, intermediate, or high—using approved disinfectants like chlorine bleach, alcohol, or Barbicide, with specified contact times. Single-use items such as razors and neck strips must be discarded immediately after use, and sharps disposed of in designated containers. Facilities must maintain adequate supplies of soap, paper towels, disinfectants, and PPE, and ensure proper lighting and sanitation in all areas. Staff training in IPAC (Infection Prevention and Control) is mandatory, with refresher courses every two years, and records of training, exposures, and equipment maintenance must be retained for compliance and inspection.
